Campsite Reservations

- 623 new campsite reservations were made in January 2020, compared to 599 for January 2019.
- This is a 3.9% increase from January 2019

Annual Houseboat Permit Renewal



- The Annual Houseboat Permits renewals are still being processed
 - o To Date:
 - o 239 have been processed
 - o 17 are outstanding
- Delinquency Notices will be sent to houseboat owners who have not completed their 2020 Houseboat Permit renewal by March 1, 2020
- Delinquent houseboat permit renewals are subject to the Houseboat Non-Discount Renewal Fee of \$625 after January 31, 2020
- Fees and renewal documents must be received by February 29, 2020
- Renewals not received by February 29, 2020 will be assessed a \$275.00 non-compliance fine and the houseboat will be "Red-Tagged" prohibiting operation of the houseboat until fees and all Houseboat Permit Application requirements are met
