FISCAL REPORT December 2018

Due to the TID year-end audit process, the fiscal information for December 2018 has not been submitted to DPRA.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

RESERVATIONS:

- 599 new campsite reservations were made in January 2019, compared to 517 for January 2018.
- This is a 13.7% increase from January 2018.

ANNUAL HOUSEBOAT PERMIT RENEWAL

- The Annual Houseboat Permit Renewals are still being processed.
 - To date:
 - o 238 renewals have been processed
 - 19 are outstanding
 - Delinquency Notices have been sent to houseboat owners who have not completed their 2019 Houseboat Permit renewal
 - Delinquent houseboat permit renewals are subject to the Houseboat Non-Discount Renewal Fee of \$525
 - Fees and renewal documents must be received by February 28, 2019
 - Renewals not received by February 28, 2019 will be assessed a \$275.00 non-compliance fine and the houseboat will be "Red-Tagged" prohibiting operation of the houseboat until fees and all Houseboat Permit Application requirements are met
 - Staff will have on time registration passes applied to houseboats by February 28th (In progress) and late payment passes applied by April 30th

ADMINISTRATION

- Rafting Special Use Permits Renewals were mailed out on 1/9/19
 - Annual rafters meeting will be hosted by CCSF on March 20, 2019
- Visitor's Center Rebuild
 - Meeting with insurance company conducted 2/7/19.
 - Reviewed cost escalations, design contingency, contractor procurement, and rebuild timeline
 - DPRA Staff has been clearing dead and overgrown vegetation from site

- Recreation Division Manager second interviews conducted on 1/31/19
- Customer Service Rep I-II Cashier recruitment in progress
- Recruitment for Park Maintenance Worker I-II is in progress
- Seasonal recruitment has started
- Director Collett returned from LOA on 2/1 on a limited basis until his retirement on June 1, 2019. For continuity of operations, Jim McCoy

will continue to be the Interim Recreation Department Manager for DPRA

OPERATIONS:

Facility preparation for 2019 season:

- Mowing will begin at lagoon lawn about once every 3 weeks and verifying proper sprinkler operation.
- Will conduct annual service on mules
- Winterize pipes at all 3 campgrounds
- Tuolumne River Arm and Moccasin Creek woody debris
 - Will continue to monitor and collect debris
 - Will add more debris boom to Moccasin Creek
- Annual permits are being applied to all on-project boats, PWC's, and SC vessels
- Regulatory and hazard Buoys
 - Staff will continue to monitor and inspect buoy lines
 - Buoy and hardware order
- Herbicide application all DPRA areas (Fleming Meadows, Blue Oaks and Moccasin)
 - Service all application equipment
 - Training for herbicide spray
 - Apply herbicide to Wreck Bay, Graveyard, and all hiking trails
- Vessel operation training
 - Train personnel on basic start up, shut down, and basic operation procedures
- HQ site clean up
 - Tree service to remove remaining problematic pines
 - o Prune, trim, or remove remaining neglected shrubbery
 - Rock work landscaping
