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## FISCAL REPORT - DECEMBER 2020

#### Revenue

Due to the TID year-end audit process, the fiscal information for December 2020 has not been submitted to DPRA.

### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

#### **Campsite Reservations**

- 868 new campsite reservations were made in January 2021, compared to 623 for January 2020.
- This is a 28% increase from January 2020.



#### **Annual Houseboat Permit Renewal**

- The Annual Houseboat Permits renewals are still being processed
  - o To Date:
    - 231 have been processed
    - 25 are outstanding
    - 1 remains vacant
- Delinquency Notices will be sent to houseboat owners who have not completed their 2021
   Houseboat Permit renewal by March 1, 2021
- Delinquent houseboat permit renewals are subject to the Houseboat Non-Discount Renewal Fee of \$625 after January 31, 2021
- Fees and renewal documents must be received by February 28, 2021
- Renewals not received by February 28, 2021 will be assessed a \$300.00 non-compliance fine and the houseboat will be "Red-Tagged" prohibiting operation of the houseboat until fees and all Houseboat Permit Application requirements are met

#### **Administration**

- Food Locker Replacement year 1 of 5 year project
  - Requisition sent to TID Purchasing to begin process for ordering
- Roadwork
  - 2021 project in planning stage
  - Serpentine Road discussion February 12, 2021
    - Currently reviewing environmental requirements
- Vehicles
  - Requisition submitted January 2021
- Fishing Cleaning Station Upgrade
  - Purchase Pending; Expected Installation Fall 2021
- Moccasin Water Tank Refurbishment
  - Planning begun January 2021
- Debris Barrier Boom (Fund 002)
  - Purchase Pending
