PERMITS	An appropriate use permit is required for all access to the Recreation Area.
ANIMALS	Wild animals are protected in the Recreation Area. If there is a problem with an animal, Please contact a Park Ranger.
CURFEW	A parent, guardian, or adult acting as their guardian must accompany persons under the age of 18 when outside of their campsite between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
QUIET TIME	Quiet time in the Recreation Area is between 10 p.m. & 7 a.m.
CHECK-OUT/CHECK-IN TIME	The campsite check out time is 11 a.m. Check in time is 4 p.m.
